Directions for Use

DISINFECTION/FUNGICIDAL/VIRUCIDAL USE SOLUTION:

- 1. Pre-clean heavily soiled areas.
- 2. Apply a use solution of 0.5 oz of this product per gallon of water (or equivalent use dilution) to disinfect hard, non-porous surfaces with a sponge, brush, cloth, mop, by immersion, auto scrubber or mechanical spray device. For sprayer applications, spray 6-8 inches from surface. Do not breathe spray.
- 3. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes.
- 4. Allow to air dry.
- 5. Prepare a fresh solution daily or when visibly dirty.
